



% Share in Enrollment by Gender

About DepEd NCR

National Capital Region, also known as Metropolitan Manila, where DepEd NCR situated is considered as the country's premier region, being the center of political, cultural, and economic activities. This region attracts migrants from all over the country in search of better economic opportunities, jobs, and education. The region despite being the smallest region of the country encompassing an area of 619.54 square kilometers is the most densely populated region sheltering over 13 million Filipinos with a 0.97 growth rate from 2015 to 2020.

The Department of Education - National Capital Region has its quality policy consistent with national educational policies and standards gearing toward the protection and promotion of every Filipino learner to quality, equitable, complete and culture-based basic education.



DEFINITION OF TERMS

Performance Indicators refer to the several indicators computed and utilized to evaluate the educational performance in different levels of the educational system.

Gross Enrollment Rate (GER) is the total enrollment for a particular education level, regardless of age, expressed as a percentage of the eligible official school-age population of that particular level in a given school year.

Net Enrollment Rate (NER) is the enrollment in a particular education level of the official school age-group, expressed as a percentage of the corresponding population.

Cohort Survival Rate (CSR) is the percentage of cohort of learners who are able to reach Grade 6/Grade 10/Grade 12.

Completion Rate (CR) is the percentage of Grade 1 and Grade 7 entrants who complete or graduate in Elementary, Junior High School, and Senior High School.

Dropout Rate (DR) or School Leaver Rate (SLR) is the percentage of learners who do not finish a particular grade level as well as those who finish but fail to enroll in the next grade level the following school year.

Transition Rate (TR) is the percentage of learners who are able to move to the next higher level of education.

Retention Rate (RR) determines the degree of learners in a particular school year who continue to be in the school in the succeeding year.

NOTES

- Enrollment in elementary and Junior High School includes the learners with special educational needs (non-graded).
- The number of schools is counted based on the Curricular Offering Classification (COC) offered. One DOST managed (Phil. Sci HS-Main) is included in the data of public schools.
- Data on the number of public school teachers for SY 2021-2022 to SY 2022-2023 are based on Local Data Capture (Actual Teacher Inventory Positions based on PSI-POP)
- Data for Enrollment per Modality doesn't include the Non-Formal Education (ALS)


