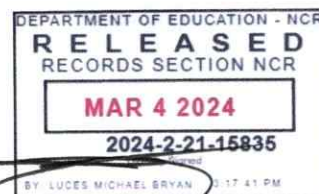

ROCKALIKASAN



ROCKALIKASAN is an annual event created as a celebration for Earth Day. It is a balance of work and play – creating awareness of various environmental issues and enjoying the beats of local music. Every year, Rockalikasan chooses a beneficiary to whom a huge portion of the proceeds is given.

Rockalikasan 2023 was held in Fitness Playground PH with over 200 attendees and six (6) rising local performers. For the Future, a youth-run NGO with the goal of providing environmental action to the Filipino youth served as its beneficiary.

FLAGSHIP EVENTS

ECOTOURISTA



ECOTOURISTA is an annual coastal or mountainous cleanup activity that promotes sustainability and preservation. Following this year's theme, "Into the Thick of It: An Exploration of the Philippines' Flora and Fauna," the organization held Ecotourista 2023: Lakbay-Linang sa Kalikasan last December 18, 2023 at the Las Piñas-Parañaque Wetland Park (LPPWP).

It is a protected area in Manila Bay that serves as a critical habitat for various flora and fauna, a sanctuary for both local and migratory birds, a spawning habitat for fish, and a vital ecosystem service for urban communities. The event also included educational discussions, attended by the members of the organization and Batch 23A applicants to raise awareness about the state of LPPWP and other similar areas.

ECOTREESTA



ECOTREESTA is a one-day event that incorporates tourism with environmental action. The organization visited one of the remaining green open spaces in Metro Manila to understand its situation better. Envisioning a harmonious relationship between tourism and the environment, the preservation of green spaces and communities is a step towards more walkable cities and sustainable transportation.

Ecotreesta 2023 was held last July 22, 2023, at UP Arboretum, a man-made forest park within the grounds of the University of the Philippines Diliman. It is one of the most significant green places in Quezon City, with 18 hectares of almost 500 unique and exotic trees, as well as a diversity of fauna and flora.

FOR THE FUTURE

UP Ecotour's **Rockalikasan 2023: ATTUNED - a Benefit Concert** focused on rekindling awareness and advocacy for environmental protection and sustainable development. The event aims to empower college students and working individuals to actively contribute to solutions through the universal medium of music. We partnered with **For the Future Philippines**, a youth-led non-governmental organization (NGO) established in 2019 that originated as a small reforestation project. With a simple goal to create a better future for everyone, they have mobilized to over 60 areas across the Philippines and have raised \$400,000. Over half of its operational expenses are covered by donations and grants to support its diverse projects, including tree planting, student sponsorship, food security, immediate aid, community support, and wildlife conservation. **The organization envisions a self-sustainable Philippines, preserving nature and empowering communities**, and UP Ecotour's raised funds play an important role in supporting these initiatives and forwarding the cause of environmental protection.

UP ARBORETUM

EcoTreesta 2023 centered its efforts on **UP Arboretum**, a man-made forest park on the Diliman campus of the University of the Philippines. Covering 18 hectares and featuring nearly 500 unique and exotic trees, as well as a rich variety of fauna and flora. It has evolved from a wildlife sanctuary to a community housing around 6,000 residents, including the designated area known as Pook Arboretum. The organization aimed to foster a harmonious relationship between tourism and the environment, actively promoting awareness and advocating for the preservation of green spaces in cities and communities. The organization also played a role in seed and tree planting efforts. **Recognizing the urgency of creating more natural spaces for an enhanced quality of life in urban areas**, UP Ecotour remains committed to its journey with UP Arboretum, emphasizing the need for preservation in compliance with legislation.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

DOMESTIKWHIZ

Domestikwhiz is the flagship event of the organization. It is an inter-university quiz bee held to promote domestic tourism and to foster camaraderie among college students, as they are among the stakeholders and the future of the tourism industry. With the expansion of the event into the National Congress on Environmental Sustainability, Domestikwhiz now becomes a highlight event of the congress.

PLENARY DISCUSSIONS

Included in the NCES 2024 program are **plenary discussions** that are geared toward fostering environmental protection and cultural awareness. These are a series of short and carefully prepared talks and presentations delivered by esteemed speakers in the industry focusing on topics grounded in situating the role of the youth in the future and sustainable development.

KALIKHASAN

The **kaLIKHAsan** is an art competition that aims to show the intersection of environmental protection and cultural heritage online. By integrating the Philippine culture and environment, the participants of this competition will aim to answer the question, "How can we shape a sustainable future for our cultural heritage and environment?" with a poster to be posted on online platforms. This will serve as an avenue for artists to raise environmental awareness and advocate sustainability through their craft.

DOMESTIKWHIZ GUIDELINES

CONTESTANTS

- 1.The school may send at most three (3) teams with three (3) students in each team.
- 2.Only one (1) coach must accompany the team/s.
- 3.Only students registered for the competition will be allowed to join. Hence, substitution will be prohibited during the competition proper.

COACH

- 1.The coach must be a faculty member of the college/university.
- 2.The coach shall be the only authorized person to file protests or complaints to the Board of Judges and Programs Committee during instances in the contest.
- 3.They shall be the only authorized school representative who shall participate in decision-making for special cases.

CONTEST PROPER

- 1.The coverage of the quiz bee shall include current and past events related to environmental sustainability both local and international; as well as topics associated with sustainable tourism development, and domestic tourism.
- 2.There will be three (3) rounds - elimination, semi-final, and final.
- 3.The elimination round will be a written examination conducted simultaneously with the speakers' talks while the semi-final and final rounds will be conducted live on stage.
- 4.During the semi-final and final round, overseers will be positioned alongside each participating team.

5. Colored flags will be used to indicate the answers:

- Green – Correct Answer
- Red – Incorrect Answer
- Yellow – No Answer

6. Quiz Bee Rounds:

ELIMINATION ROUND

- There will be fifty (50) questions for the Elimination Round.
- Teams will be given ninety (90) minutes to answer the written exam.
- Each correct answer is worth one (1) point.
- At the end of the Elimination Round, only ten (10) teams with the highest accumulated points will advance to the Semi-Final Round.

SEMI-FINAL ROUND

- There will be fifteen (15) questions for the Semi-Final Round.
- Teams will be given fifteen (15) seconds to answer each question.
- Each correct answer is worth three (3) points.
- At the end of the Semi-Final Round, only five (5) teams with the highest accumulated points will advance to the Final Round.

FINAL ROUND

- There will be ten (10) questions for the Final Round.
- Teams will be given thirty (30) seconds to answer each question.
- Each correct answer is worth five (5) points.
- There will be ten (10) questions for the Final Round.
- Teams will be given thirty (30) seconds to answer each question.
- Each correct answer is worth five (5) points.

6. Quiz Bee Rounds:

CLINCHER ROUND

- In case of a tie at the end of the three (3) rounds, the teams concerned will proceed to the Clincher Round.
- For the Clincher Round, multiple questions will be asked until the tie is broken.
- The teams will be given fifteen (15) seconds to answer each question.

JUDGING OF WINNERS

1. A panel, composed of three (3) faculty members from the UP Asian Institute of Tourism, will serve as jurors for the quiz bee.
2. The panel, together with the organizers, will deliberate and compute the scores. The winners will be declared after the scores are tabulated.
3. The winning team will receive a cash prize, medals, and a trophy for the declared champion. The remaining teams will be given certificates.
4. Winners to be determined are:
 - Domestikwhiz Champion
 - 1st Runner-Up
 - 2nd Runner-Up
