Attached to this letter are the complete mechanics. Your office may submit your region's entries with complete supporting documents through this Drive: NCR Gurong May K Submissions. The deadline for entries is August 30, 2024.

Additionally, we request the dissemination of our call for entries to your Grades 6 and Grade 10 students for the "Kabataang May K: Knowledge Channel's Photo Essay Contest." Photo essays should capture stories on how Knowledge Channel has become an important part of students' learning experiences and education.

Participation in either competition is **free of charge**. The winner of **Gurong May K** will receive a cash prize of **50,000 pesos**, and a **Knowledge Channel TV Package** for their school. The winners of **Kabataang May K** will each receive a cash prize of **10,000 pesos**. Winners will be awarded during KCFI's 25th Anniversary celebration on November 7, 2024.

Gurong May K: Search for Best Teachers of Knowledge Channel Award Basic Education (K-10) Category

Mechanics

The Search for Gurong May K: Search for Best Teachers of Knowledge Channel Award aims to celebrate exceptional teachers in public schools, who use 21st century engagement strategies and Knowledge Channel videos in instruction.

Note: Fielding an entry for Gurong May K: Best Teachers of Knowledge Channel Awards is free of charge.

1. Eligibility

The Gurong May K nominee must be a public school teacher who:

- Has a valid PRC license for teaching;
- Is actively teaching in either kindergarten, elementary, or junior high school (K-10) for at least 2 years; and
- Uses 21st century engagement strategies and Knowledge Channel videos in lessons and activities.

2. Requirements

The Office of the Regional Director is requested to submit the following requirements on behalf of their three (3) nominees:

- Completed entry form (https://bit.ly/KCH-GMK-EF) submitted through the Office of the Regional Director.
- Supporting materials, namely:
 - Accomplished recommendation form (https://bit.ly/KCH-GMK-RF) from the Schools Division Superintendent of the nominee;
 - Photos and/or videos documenting the use of Knowledge Channel videos in the classroom;
 - Photos and/or videos documenting classroom setup and learning strategies employed;
 - Sample lesson plans and/or full daily lesson logs which integrate Knowledge Channel videos;
 - Written documentation of sample learning activities which use Knowledge Channel videos containing the activity's title, objectives, and sequential instructions, along with assessment tools and student works.

Submissions must be uploaded to the Drive provided for the Office of the Regional Director.

Deadline for submission of entries is on August 30, 2024.



3. Notification of Finalists

The top 5 finalists shall be notified on or before September 30, 2024 for their teaching demonstration and panel interview to determine the winner.

KABATAANG MAY K: Knowledge Channel Photo Essay Writing Contest

Mechanics

The Kabataang May K: Knowledge Channel Photo Essay Writing Contest searches for stories through photos and essays of students on how Knowledge Channel has become an important part of their life as leaners and impacted their education.

 Eligibility: The contest is open to Grades 6 and Grade 10 students in public schools who are enrolled during the current school year (2024-2025)

2. Requirements and Mechanics:

Participants must submit the following to the **Registration Form Link:** https://www.knowledgechannel.org/kabataang-may-k

- One high-resolution photograph showing how Knowledge Channel has become an integral part of their lives and has positively impacted their education.
 - o Entries must adhere to the following guidelines:
 - Entries must be a single photo. Photo collage will NOT be accepted.
 - The photo must NOT have been previously published in any paper/publication, submitted in any previous competitions, and/or used for commercial purposes.
 - The photo must be in high resolution. There is no requirement or limitation on the type of camera used.
 - The photo must NOT be heavily edited or digitally altered. Only cropping, adjusting of brightness, and color grading are allowed.
- A short write up that supports the photo entry on how Knowledge Channel has become an
 important part of the student's life and positively impacted their education. The accompanying
 essay must be written in either Filipino or English and has 100 to 200 words.
- Accomplished forms (https://bit.ly/KCH-KMK-RPCF):
 - Recommendation form from the school principal, school director, or teacher-incharge
 - Parent consent form signed by parent or legal guardian

Related Guidelines

- In all instances, participants should submit <u>all</u> relevant consent forms with the application form.
- Plagiarism will not be tolerated and will be a ground for disqualification.
- The use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) prompts e.g., ChatGPT, Gemini, etc. to create the submitted image or essay will disqualify the entry.
- The photo execution should have been done by the student-entrant and not by anyone else.
- Group/collaborative work is not allowed.
- Consent of Subjects: To respect people's rights and privacy, the participant must ask for permission from everyone appearing in the photo entry. Each



person appearing in the photo entry needs to agree that his/ her picture can be used in the contest and in any ads about it. If the photo entry doesn't follow this rule, the participant promises not to blame the contest organizers for any legal problems. Contest organizers might ask for proof that the participant got permission from everyone in the photo entry. This could be a signed form showing they agreed. If the participant's photo entry shows people under 18 years old, the participant must obtain consent from the subject/s parent or legal guardian. Not following these rules may result in disqualification from the contest.

Intellectual Property: The participant acknowledges that while the photo's intellectual property belongs to him/her, he/she gives KCFI all rights to use the photo entry, without KCFI needing to ask for the consent of the participant, in any way it deems appropriate for the sake of communication and marketing related to the contest and on KCFI's impact on learning and education. The participant allows KCFI to use, share, and show their photo entry in their websites, social media, and ads, without payment or other consideration. The participant acknowledges that participation in the contest does not guarantee publication or any form of compensation. The participant won't blame KCFI if there are any problems from using the photo entry, including but not limited to any claims for defamation, invasion of privacy, or infringement of moral rights. The participant must obtain consent from their parent or legal guardian to enter into this agreement.

Deadline for submission of entries is on September 7, 2024.
