Logistics and Other Details

Travel expenses for the participants are requested to be charged against available local funds and/or charged to the balance of the Program Support Funds for the Conduct of GTA Development and Harvesting of Storybooks (DM-CT-2024-06, dated June 4, 2024), or any surplus funds from activities for learning resources that allow expenditure of such.
