

REQUEST FOR PARTICIPANTS AND INVITATION FOR THE THIRD CHILD PROTECTION E-LEARNING COURSE FOR EDUCATORS

- 1. This is relative to the attached Memorandum OM-OUOPS-2025-11-00119 from **MALCOLM S. GARMA**, Assistant Secretary, Officer-in-Charge, Office of the Undersecretary for Operations, Department of Education, dated January 7, 2025, r/e: request for participants and invitation for the third child protection elearning course for educators.
- 2. The e-learning Course is a free, fully asynchronous, and accessible to both online and offline. The course is designed for educators, it aims to enhance understanding of child protection issues. It provides tools and materials to advocate for learner rights and address protection concerns. Licnesed teachers who complete the course will earn Continuing Professional Development (CPD) points, as it is accredited by the Professioan I Regulation Commission (PRC).
- 3. The course is open to both teaching and non-teaching personnel, with a slot of 700 participants in the National Capital Region. Participants may enroll and register until February 26, 2025. The course shall be self-paced and will start on March 3 and end on April 6, 2025. This Office, through the Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) in partnership with the Stairway Foundation Inc., (SFI) will launch the third batch of the Child Protection e-Learning Course for educators.

The e-Learning Course shall be fully asynchronous, accessible online and offline, free of charge, and open to both teaching and non-teaching personnel. The Course is designed for educators to develop a deeper understanding of all child protection concerns, both online and offline. The Course aims to provide educators with tools and educational materials that may be used to advocate learner rights and address learner rights and protection concerns. Licensed teachers who are able to complete the Course shall earn

Continuing Professional Development (CPD) points, as the e-Learning Course has received accreditation from the Professional Regulation: Commission (PRC).

Accordingly, we requested the assistance of the Regional Office in identifying teaching and non-teaching personnel who will undergo the course. The request is made to ensure an increased number of Course completers and allow our Regional and Division focals to check their progress.



The LRPO and Stairway Child Protection e-learning course for Educators

What is the course about?

The course is specifically designed for educators in order for them to develop a deeper understanding of the various child protection concerns that their learners might face both offline and online. Specially crafted by the DepEd Learner Rights and Protection Office and Stairway Foundation, the course aims to empower educators to be have the knowledge and tools to participate more in the protection of the children they work with.

How is the course delivered?

The course is **fully asynchronous and self-paced**, and thus, you can take the lessons at any time depending in your availability. The course contains short videos lessons, interactive content and resource links. There shall be no webinars.

Objectives of the Course

At the end of the course, participants are expected to;

- Identify the various offline and online child protection concerns that learners might encounter.
- 2. Identify the various means these child protection concerns might be perpetrated.
- 3. Identify the various means of integrating Child Protection into their lessons.
- 4. Distinguish what DepEd policy and protocol should be applied for specific child protection concerns.
- 5. Be introduced to the various initiatives of DepEd in relation to child protection

Important details to remember:

- 1. Course starts on March 3 to April 6, 2025.
- 2. The course is credited with CPD points by the PRC Board of Teachers. Other professions will not be able to get CPD credits.
- In the course completers survey, which you will complete towards the end of the course, ensure that the details you will enter corresponds to what is indicated in your current PRC License.
- 4. Please ensure that you finish the course completers survey on or before the course end date, as this is what we shall send to the PRC for successful course completers.



Technical Requirements:

- An internet connection –broadband wired or wireless (3G or 4G/LTE) minimum 5 to 10MBPs
- Speakers

 built-in, headset or USB plug-in or wireless Bluetooth
- We recommend that you access this course using a desktop or laptop (Windows or Mac)
- Even though you will still be able to access the course via tablets or mobile phones, we highly recommend that you use desktops or laptops for an optimal user experience
- The quality of your Internet connection will also greatly affect your user experience.

Course Enrollment Guidelines

In order to participate in the course, please refer to the following steps/information;

- 1.) Create a Stairway e-learning account (if you don't have an existing one yet)
- 2.) Provide to your LRPO focal the email address you used to create a Stairway e-learning account.
- 3.) Your LRPO focal shall forward the list to the LRPO for enrollment. Once the course starts, if you have been successfully enrolled, the course should appear in your course dashboard, which you can access by logging in to your Stairway e-learning account.

How to create a Stairway e-learning account?

If you already have an existing Stairway e-learning account, you do not need to create a new one. You just have to provide to your LRPO focal the email address you used to create your existing Stairway e-learning account.

If you do not have an existing Stairway e-learning account, please create a Stairway e-learning account.



There are 2 options for creating a Stairway e-learning account. We recommend option 1 as much as possible.

Option 1: Recommended (For those with Gmail/DepEd accounts)

- a. Please follow this link https://elearning.stairwayfoundation.org/login/index.php
 - b. Ensuring that you have a working and accessible Gmail account, click on the "Log in using your account on:" Click Google



c. You will be redirected to the Google account page; choose the Google account you want your e-learning account to be associated with.





d. Every time you will login to the e-learning platform, just repeat this option, which you can access again via the home page by clicking on "Moodle Login Page" via https://elearning.stairwayfoundation.org/ogin/index.php



Option 2: (for Gmail and non-Gmail account holders)

- Login to your Stairway eLearning account, or if you do not have one yet, create an account on this platform via this link https://bit.ly/StairwayELearningSignUp
- b. In creating a user account, please ensure that you shall use a valid and accessible email address, double checking for any spelling errors.
- c. After successfully entering all the required details, an account creation email shall be sent your email. Please click on this to confirm activation. If the account confirmation email can't be found in your inbox, please check your spam folder

Once you have successfully created a Stairway e-learning account, please provide to your LRPO focal the email address you used to create an e-learning account so that we can in turn, enroll you. Your LRPO focal shall forward the list to the LRPO for enrollment. Once the course starts, if you have been successfully enrolled, the course should appear in your course dashboard, which you can access by logging in to your Stairway e-learning account.
