Dear **Dir. Andaya**,

Based on the Morbidity Week 7 Report of the Regional Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (RESU) of the Metro Manila Center for Health Development (MMCHD), there were 8,469 dengue cases admitted at the different reporting institutions in the National Capital Region (NCR) from January 1- February 15, 2025. This is 183% higher compared to the same period in 2024 and surpassed the Epidemic Threshold. There were 27 deaths reported in the region and the most affected age group was 10-14 years old.

To control the increase of dengue cases and deaths in Metro Manila, may we request your good office to release a memorandum to all public and private elementary schools in the National Capital Region reiterating the reactivation of School Dengue Brigades and implementation of the following Integrated Vector Control (IVC) Activities in collaboration with the City Health Offices (CHOs).

1. Search and Destroy or Source Reduction
2. Installation of Ovi/Larvi (OL) Traps
3. Preventive Space Spraying as identified by the CHOs
4. Targeted Indoor/Outdoor Residual Spraying
5. Installation of Insecticide Treated Screens (ITS)
