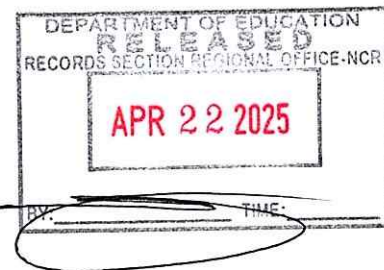

**REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE IN SITE VALIDATION FOR PPP FOR SCHOOL
INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT PHASE 3 (PSIP Phase 3).**

1. The Department of Education is preparing to launch a new wave of Public-Private Partnerships (PPP) for classroom construction, covering the design, financing, and construction of at least 15,000 classrooms across eight (8) regions. This initiative is expected to benefit over 600,000 learners nationwide.
2. Since September 2024, DepEd has been actively collaborating with the PPP Center to develop the PPP for School Infrastructure Project Phase 3 (PSIP 3). A crucial part of this preparation is ensuring the accuracy and completeness of data regarding the validity, accessibility, and ownership status of school sites.
3. While PSIP Phases 1 and 2 successfully delivered classrooms and related infrastructure, both projects faced considerable challenges, particularly due to site-related issues such as inaccessibility, security concerns, geotechnical problems, obstructions, and delays in the provision of substitute sites.
4. To help address these challenges early on, we are requesting support in validating the site ownership and conducting site assessments for the schools identified under PSIP 3.
