

In support to the Department of Education's 5-point agenda, the Operations Strand and the Bureau of Learner Support Services (BLSS), through the Youth Formation Division (YFD) and Learner Rights and Protection Division (LRPD), intends to conduct a **Data Gathering and Consultation on the Development of the Learners' Handbook** via **Microsoft Forms** from **May 1** to **30**, **2025**.

- gather and analyze additional data from field offices to enhance the scope and relevance of the handbook's content, ensuring it is practical, inclusive, and adaptable for nationwide implementation; and
- c. prepare a comprehensive report consolidating all relevant data, insights, and stakeholder inputs, which will serve as a foundational resource for the upcoming writeshop activity.
