# 2025 REGIONAL ORIENTATION OF CORE TRAINERS ON SNED: CONTENT, PEDAGOGY, POLICIES, ILRC, MULTIDISCIPLINARY, TEAM COLLABORATION AND IEP DEVELOPMENT FOR I.E.

- 1. The Department of Education-NCR (DepEd-NCR) in adherence to its commitment to strengthen the advocacy to provide equal and equitable education that is inclusive and responsive to the needs of the learners will conduct the above-captioned activity on June 2-6, 2025 (Batch 1) and June 9-13, 2025 (Batch 2), within Zambales, specific venue to be announced.
- 2. The activity aims to:
  - a. orient the Division School Heads, Head Teachers, Receiving Teachers, Elementary, Secondary, Senior High School and SPED Teachers (newly hired only) on SNED Programs; and
  - b. enable, equip and enhance their skills, knowledge, understanding and capabilities in implementing SNED programs effectively in Schools.
- 3. Participants in this activity are the SNED Education Program Supervisors/Coordinators, Head Teachers, Receiving Teachers, Elementary, Secondary, Senior High School and SPED Teachers (newly hired only). - 4. SDOs are given the discretion to identify their participants who should come from different schools. Division SNED focal people are requested to facilitate/assist in the preparation of the travel authority of the identified participants.
- 5. Board and lodging and other expenses such as supplies and materials shall be charged against SNED FUNDS, while travel and other incidental expenses of the participants, speakers, facilitators and SDO technical group (RTWG) shall be charged against downloaded SNED funds, or local funds, whichever is available, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

- 6. Identified RO and SDO TWG members are expected to be at the venue on June 1 and June 8, 2025, respectively, for Day 0, to attend the pre-workshop on-site preparations. They shall be entitled to a service credit or COC. Likewise, the participants for June 9-13, 2025 shall also be entitled to the same for June 12 (Philippine Independence Day), pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 and CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004, subject to existing government rules and regulations on the grant of service credit and COC.
