The Department of Education (DepEd), through the signed Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) dated January 8, 2025, entered into a partnership agreement with the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP) and BDO Foundation to further strengthen the integration of financial literacy program in the K to 12 Curriculum.

In line with BSP's broader financial inclusion strategy and the Department's goal of integrating financial literacy into basic education, the partnership brought the development of financial education (FinEd) learning resources (LRs).
