The School-based Immunization (SBI) program, a collaboration between the Department of Health (DOH) and the Department of Education (DepEd), aims to protect children from vaccine-preventable diseases (VPDs) such as measles, rubella, tetanus, diphtheria, and human papillomavirus (HPV).
